- **ENTER CAMPUS AT CORRECT ENTRANCE**
- There will be volunteers to help unload your vehicle and bring items to room
- Shenandoah vehicles must be moved directly after unloading
- Rappahannock vehicles have 30-minute unloading time
- Campus shuttles will be running to take you to and from long-term parking

Shenandoah Neighborhood

- **ENTER CAMPUS VIA BRADDOCK ROAD**
 - Turn Left on Roanoke River Road
 - Follow signs to Lot C (Check-in)
 - Continue onto Patriot Circle
- Turn right onto Presidents Park Drive
Sorted into Park 1, Park 2, and Taylor
- **Unload vehicle: Driver must stay with vehicle**




Rappahannock Neighborhood

- **ENTER CAMPUS VIA UNIVERISTY DRIVE**
- **Follow traffic to Rappahannock Parking Deck**
- **Enter Parking deck, turn right to the ground floor**
 - **Ground floor is the unloading zone**
- **Families are allowed to park in the Deck long term upon initial arrival**
- *If you leave the parking deck, you will be asked to park in long term parking areas upon return*

Coordinate with your roommate on items you can share (fridge, microwave, etc.)

LABEL EVERYTHING!

How to Pack?



Refrigerator

- Up to 3 cubic feet, operate at 118, must not exceed 180 watts

Microwaves

- .6 cubic feet, must not exceed 900 watts
